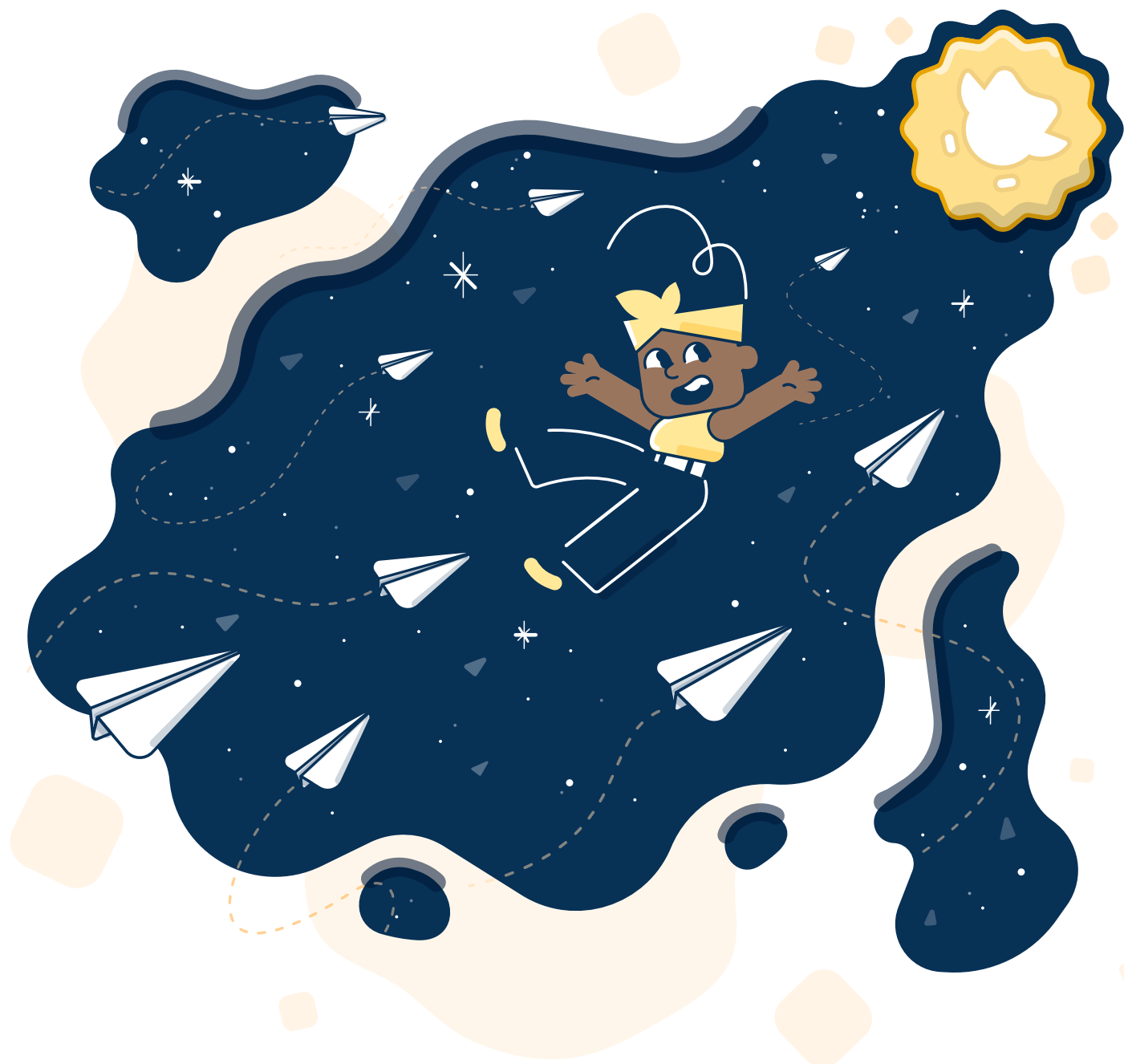

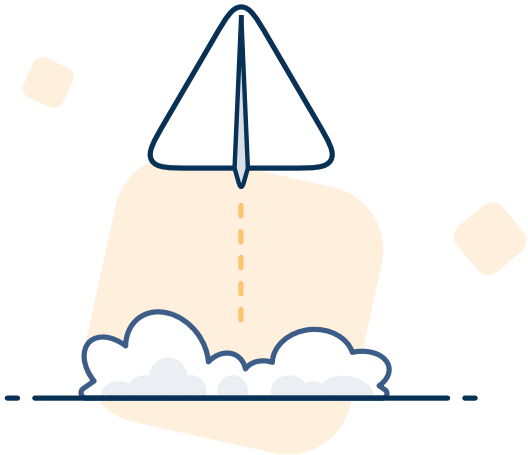

# 如何充分备考

## 概述

在这个部分，您将了解到如何为参加多邻国英语测试做好准备。该部分内容还包括测试机制、学习英语的小妙招，以及制定考试计划的建议。

## 关于备考

多邻国是一家语言学习公司，致力于为每个人降低接受教育的门槛。因此，多邻国英语测试的“备考”可能和您平常所见略有不同。

提及备考，人们通常会联想到冗长的学习时间、昂贵的考试材料和大量需要背诵记忆的内容。传统备考方式所带来的压力，往往会导致考试焦虑，产生负面的影响。与传统备考不同，参加多邻国英语测试要做的准备更像是一个循序渐进、蓄势待发过程。

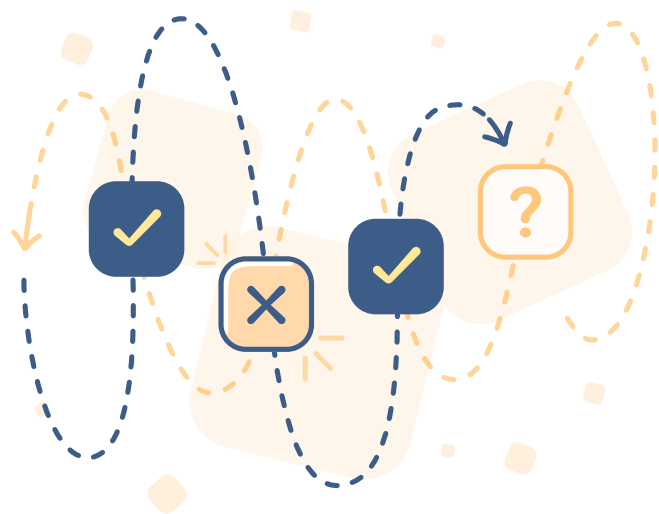
## 不为考试而学是真正的学习

## 如何提升英语技能

为考试做准备的最佳方式是尽量让自己沉浸在英语环境中，其实有很多方法可以帮助您在测试前提升英语技能。

在传授或学习一门外语时，许多人注重口语、写作、阅读和听力。为了帮助您提升这些技能的水平，以下是多邻国博客上 (blog.duolingo.com) 分享的一些热门建议。

### 🗣️ 口语

- 您可以利用在家或独处的时间，跟自己大声说英语。内容可以讲述自己在做什么，或者说出自己在考虑计划安排某事时进行思考的过程。您甚至可以挑战一下，描述某些熟悉的传统习俗，或是讲讲自己印象深刻的儿时记忆。口语中很重要的一环就是调取使用记忆中的词汇，而这一练习无需任何外部资源，您可以随时随地自己进行。
- 当您独自观看英文电影或视频时，可以尝试复述听到的内容，有意锻炼您的舌头和大脑，练习发音。遇到有趣的台词和妙句时，可以先记下来，然后在自己练习口语时试着运用这些词句。
- 您可能会觉得英语里有某些发音难以掌握，其实大概率是，其他人也会有同样的问题。您可以上网搜一搜与这些发音相关的指导视频，对您纠正发音会有所帮助。

### ✍️ 写作

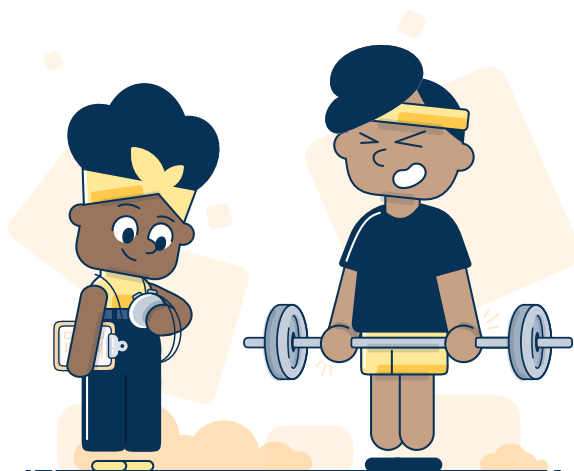
- 练习写作的一个简单便捷的方法是用英语来写购物清单。如果您习惯每天都写任务清单的话，也可以尝试用英语来列出自己一天要做的事情。
- 将手机或电脑切换成英文键盘，这样就可以练习用英语发短信、搜索和在社交媒体上发帖。
- 在社媒上找一些用英语交流的群组，可以先尝试用英语进行简单回复，也许不用多久您就能写出很长的一段话了。
- 回答篇幅稍长的写作题时，主要论点一定要辅以相关细节作出扩展说明，并通过举例进行论证。最好能利用不同的连接词来明确表达各层意思之间的关系。

### 📖 阅读

- 阅读英文博客、关注英文社交媒体帐号以及加入用英文发帖的群组。
- 阅读英语文章和新闻。通常，您可以利用自己的时事知识来理解内容。
- 阅读维基百科英文版和英文书籍，可以先从自己熟悉的话题入手；也可以重读自己最爱书籍的英文版本或译本。

### 🎧 听力

- 听英语歌曲。音乐朗朗上口，重复的歌词可以帮助您更轻松地记住有用的短语。听到有趣的歌词时，不妨查查看是什么意思！
- 观看电视节目或电影时，把音频语言切换到英语。观看以英语制作或带英文字幕的电影也有助于练习听力。
- 下载英文软件或播客。寻找与新闻、体育、历史、时尚相关的内容——任何您想用母语来听到的话题都可以！有些软件可能也会有很多对语言学习有帮助的视频。



## 如何在测试中达到最佳状态

您可以选择在合适的时间和地点，在身心状态最佳的时候参加测试。

### 保持心情放松、身体舒适、精力充沛

- 把测试安排在在您一天中状态最佳的时间。
- 保证前一晚的睡眠质量。
- 测试前去洗手间。
- 测试前确保饮水充足。（但请记住，测试一旦开始就不能离开电脑，因此再次强调，请一定要在测试前去洗手间！）
- 测试前可以吃些对脑力有帮助的零食。

### 提前准备、进入状态

- 阅读或观看一些英语读物和视频。
- 尝试进行英语冥想，让自己冷静、专注。
- 在测试前运动一下，或做一些平静身心的活动。

### 确保隐私

- 除拍摄记录电脑屏幕所需的手机外，将所有设备放置于其他房间并保持关闭状态。
- 收起所有纸笔；做笔记是违反考规的行为。
- 提醒附近的人不要打扰您。

### 检查设备

- 确保电脑和手机电量充足或全程充电。
- 确认互联网连接良好。
- 检查身份证件，确保证件未过期。
- 摘掉耳机并置于其他房间。

## 如何把握测试节奏

准备考试时请按照自己的节奏进行。本测试旨在衡量您的英语水平，而不是您对测试本身的了解程度，因此如果您已经准备好，现在就可以参加测试啦！

### 测试前

- 前往 [englishtest.duolingo.cn](https://englishtest.duolingo.cn) 免费创建帐户，只需提供有效的邮箱地址即可。
- 登入帐户，熟悉测试。除本指南和样题外，网站还提供许多其他免费备考资源。
- 在考前的几天，尽可能强化英语练习。
- 确定参加测试的时间和地点，并准备好场地和设备。

### 测试中

- 开始测试之前，请参考“如何在测试中达到最佳状态”，以确保调整适当的心态。不要忘记重温测试规则。
- 参加测试时，不要将视线从屏幕上移开，也不要退出测试应用；避免频繁查看计时器。
- 完成测试后，请先等待测试全部上传完毕，再离开多邻国英语测试桌面应用。当测试上传完成后，您会在屏幕上收到通知。

### 测试后

- 您会在 48 小时内收到测试结果。如果购买了加急出分的话，考完后 12 小时内即可收到测试结果。您可以登录官网，在您的多邻国英语测试帐户中查看。
- 收到经认证的测试结果后，就可以开始发送成绩。
- 您可以随时向认可院校分享经认证的测试结果，数量不限，且无需额外费用。

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# 测试结构

## 概述

在这一部分，您将了解到测试的形式、组成部分和测试时长。您还能进一步了解计算机自适应测试的相关信息，及其对您测试体验的影响。

## 视频介绍

观看多邻国英语测试网站([go.duolingo.com/walkthrough](https://go.duolingo.com/walkthrough)) 或 Bilibili 频道上的视频介绍是帮助您了解测试结构的最佳方法之一。视频内的测试者会逐步完成测试的每一部分，包括考前准备和测试上传。



## 测试时长

您将需要大约 1 小时不受干扰的时间来完成多邻国英语测试，请确保不受干扰。

## 关于自适应测试

多邻国英语测试是一项计算机自适应测试，这可能与您之前参加的其他测试有所不同。

## 难度变换

在整个测试过程中，考题的难度会不断变化。考题难度的不一致正是自适应测试的特点之一。

## 自适应长度

每场测试的考题总数并不固定，具体数量取决于评分引擎。当评分引擎认定分数已足具代表性时，测试就会结束。

## 独特的体验

考题的源题库非常庞大。无论参加多少次测试，见到相同题目的可能性都微乎其微。

## 测试组成部分

在您开始测试后，系统将引导您完成以下三个部分：

### 1. 介绍和准备（大约 5 分钟）

- 确保电脑的摄像头、扬声器和麦克风功能正常。
- 打开手机摄像头准备对电脑屏幕进行录像。
- 上传由政府颁发的带有照片的身份证件。
- 查看测试规则和要求。

### 2. 自适应测试（大约 45 分钟）

- 通过让您回答一系列的不同题型来衡量英语水平。
- 考题难度会随您的答题表现而变化。

### 3. 口语样本和写作样本（大约 10 分钟）

- 系统会给出一个命题，您需要就此命题充分发挥，以口头或书面作答。
- 口语样本的回答时间为 1~3 分钟，写作样本的回答时间为 3~5 分钟。
- 测试获得认证后可查看自己在这两部分的回答。接收测试结果的院校将可以看到您的口语和写作样本。

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# 测试题型

## 概述

在这一部分，您将了解多邻国英语测试的各种题型。各题型的描述中包含重要的答题

## 一般建议

以下是一些适用于多邻国英语测试所有题型的有用策略和应试习惯，包括应试策略、写作和口语建议。

### 应试策略

- 充分利用时间，详尽回答问题，答题的速度快并不会提高分数。



- 答题时尽量充分发挥，增加答案长度，不要止步于题目的最低要求。例如，写作字数最好能超过 50 个单词；口语陈述时间最好长于 30 秒。在有效使用英语且不跑题的前提下，回答越完善，分数越高。
- 提交每一题答案之前，请利用时间修正答案。在点击“NEXT”进入下一题之前，您的任何错误都不会被扣分。一旦点击“NEXT”，您将无法返回之前的题目进行修改。
- 避免过于频繁地查看计时器，因为这会分散注意力，影响您的正常发挥。
- 预留出检查答案的时间，每道题答完后，先检查，再提交。

## 写作建议

- 使用正确的拼写、语法、标点符号和大小写。多邻国英语测试接受美式和英式拼写。唯一的例外是 Read and Complete（阅读填空）题型，此题型只允许美式拼写。
- 尽量变换句子结构和用词。使用较为多样、复杂的词汇和语法可以帮助您获得更高的分数。

## 口语建议

- 尽量使用正常语速，保持声音洪亮、清晰。
- 口语题的回答不能重新录制，因此即使您在回答过程中出现错误，也要继续。
- 确保在完成整个回答后再提交录音。
- 和写作一样，尽量变换句子结构和用词。



## 关于题型说明

在本节中您将了解到有关各种测试题型的所有信息。下文中对每种题型的介绍将包含以下几个元素：

- 示例：真实考题的图片。
- 说明：题目要求。
- 时限：完成任务的规定时间。
- 建议：答题建议，包含两部分：
  - **回答问题**：有用的应试策略和语言习惯
  - **互动操作**：如何在电脑上完成测试
- 单项分数：根据该题型评估的单项分数。

单项分数一共有 8 项，分别为 Listening（听）、Speaking（说）、Reading（读）、Writing（写）、Literacy（读&写）、Conversation（听&读）、Comprehension（听&说）以及 Production（说&写）。
